

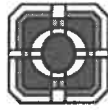

We have completed our review of your Freedom of Information request and it is granted in part and denied in part. Attached are copies of the responsive records. Please note that this request is partially denied because the records you have requested contain information that is exempt from disclosure under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act. 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(b). Specifically, the Village has redacted unique identifiers which are considered private information and exempt from disclosure. The Village relied on section 5 ILCS 140/7(1) (b) which states that '*Private information*' means unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5).

Additionally, 705 ILCS 405/5(2) requires the withholding of information identifying an alleged minor victim of a sex crime. Thus all audio/video recordings containing this information have been denied in whole.

You have a right to have this response to your request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor ("PAC") at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a).

NARRATIVE

On 08/13/14 at approximately 1703 hours, I was dispatched to a harassment by TX complaint.

Upon speaking with the complainant, [REDACTED] she advised that her 14yo daughter [REDACTED] received text messages from her boyfriend, [REDACTED] co-worker, Anthony, a 46yo male.

The text messages exchanged occurred between 1700 hours on 08/03/13 and 0300 hours on 08/04/13.

The number texting her daughter was [REDACTED] which is believed to belong to Anthony. Anthony obtained [REDACTED] information at a work party earlier in the day on 08/03/13, in which the family went with Glenn to the party. It is believed he obtained her email first then started texting her.

The messages from [REDACTED] involve asking the juvenile if she drinks, asking her if she was interested in piercings other than the belly button, comments that he likes nipple piercings or "other places", asks if she can sneak out for an overnight visit so he can take her to get her belly button pierced, calls her a "sexy dork", asks if she would like to "mess around with" him, would ever consider getting to know him romantically, he asked her to send him a picture message of her belly, face, full-clothed or whatever she wanted to send him.

[REDACTED] came forth to her mother about the texts on the night of 08/12/13.

[REDACTED] had her daughter delete the messages from her phone because she did not want to subject her daughter to see them anymore, but did have the messages saved through cell phone screen shots. The screen shots were sent by email to Glenn who forwarded them to my email.

The messages were printed out, inventoried and placed into ERPS.

Child was not interviewed or brought to the station by parents. Both parents expressed interest in being present when child is interviewed.

Nothing further.

NARRATIVE

On 8/15/2013 I (Inv. Dawn Gorman-Kenny) was assigned an indecent solicitation of a child investigation. I made contact with the victim's mother, [REDACTED] and advised her I would need to speak with [REDACTED] advised she would bring her in at 1830 hours today. I also requested [REDACTED] cell phone be brought in for an examination and to obtain the text messages from them. [REDACTED] advised she would drop the cell phone off immediately and I had already been contacted by [REDACTED] father, owner of the cell phone, and forwarded him the consent to search form for the cell phone via email. At approximately 1300 hours [REDACTED] dropped the cell phone off to me at the station and I received the signed consent form from [REDACTED] and gave both to Inv. Eric Rossi to conduct the forensic exam of the phone (see his supplemental report).

Inv. Rossi provided me with the original CD and a working CD of the cell phone examination; the original CD will be placed into evidence along with the original signed consent to search form for the cell phone. At 1830 hours I was advised by our front desk that [REDACTED] and her father were at the station to meet with me. I went to the lobby area and met with [REDACTED] and her father [REDACTED] and advised [REDACTED] that I would need to speak with [REDACTED] alone first. I brought [REDACTED] back to the investigations area soft interview room and asked her if she knew why I needed to speak with her. [REDACTED] advised yes, it was about what a co-worker of her moms boyfriend [REDACTED] texted her. I asked her to tell me what happened and she related the following in summary not verbatim.

[REDACTED] is 14 years old and was attending a work party on 8/3/13 at the home of Glens boss; she was there with her mother, brother, and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised while at the party co-workers of [REDACTED] were also there and at one point [REDACTED] advised Tony was standing at the table she was at with her mom, [REDACTED] and her brother and they were all talking. [REDACTED] advised they got to the party she thought around 1:30 p.m. and Tony appeared about an hour later. [REDACTED] advised she recognized Tony as [REDACTED] co-worker because she had been to [REDACTED] work in the past. Tony joined [REDACTED] group at a tall table and was talking with them. At one point Tony saw [REDACTED] cartilidge piercing on her ear and asked if she would want her nose or belly button pierced next. [REDACTED] said her belly button but her mom would not let her. I asked [REDACTED] if Tony asked this with [REDACTED] and her mom there and she advised yes.

[REDACTED] advised they continued talking at the table with Tony and others and she had spoke about her recent trip to Jamaica where she swam with the dolphins. [REDACTED] advised she and her family were getting ready to leave the party sometime after 5:00 p.m. because they were attending a concert that evening. Tony asked [REDACTED] for her email address and [REDACTED] gave him her old email address, [REDACTED] because she does not use it anymore. [REDACTED] advised shortly after providing this to Tony she received a text on her iPhone from [REDACTED]

NARRATIVE CONTINUATION

[redacted] that said "test" [redacted] advised she was still at the party and did not recognize the cell phone number but with the other texts from the same number believed it to be Tony. [redacted] advised the texts were about what she had just talked with Tony about at the party (for further see CD of texts). [redacted] advised she received the texts only on 8/3/13 and after the concert on 8/4/13 and they were from the above number requesting her to send a picture of herself, and to make arrangements to sneak out of house and the person texting would help her get her belly button pierced without her parent's knowing. [redacted] advised she only sent a picture of a dolphin. I advised [redacted] I viewed the texts sent from her phone and there was a text sent by [redacted] saying "mines [redacted] pics are on there". I asked [redacted] what that was and she advised it was her screen name for instagram but she blocked Tony from it as soon as she sent it to him. Tony had given her his screen name of [redacted]

[redacted] advised she didn't say anything to her mom until recently because she did not know what to do. Once she showed her mom the texts and who she thought it was, the phone number the texts came from was confirmed by [redacted] as Tony's work phone number. I asked her if she told anyone prior to her mother and she advised she told her friend [redacted] and she told her to tell her mom. [redacted] advised she sent screen shots to [redacted] I asked [redacted] if he tried contacting her in any other way and she advised no. I brought [redacted] back to the lobby area and met in the soft interview room there with her mom, dad and mom's boyfriend and advised them of what she said. I asked [redacted] if she was present when the conversation about the belly button piercing came up and she advised yes, it was a brief conversation and she said she would not allow [redacted] to get it.

I advised them that contact would be made with Tony and that they would be notified when that happens. [redacted] advised me that the phone number used was a work phone and that the owner of the company was currently out of town but returning Monday.

NARRATIVE

On 8/20/13 I, (Inv. Dawn Gorman-Kenny) along with Inv. Doug Kein, proceeded out to Tony's place of employment at approximately 1015 hours. We were met at the door by an employee and we advised we needed to speak with the owner, Sean Morrison. We were brought to a small conference room inside and met with Sean there. We advised Sean about the incident and the text messages sent to [REDACTED] from one of his company's cell phones used by Tony Martin and asked for a consent to search the cell phone. Sean called Tony into the conference room and he brought his work phone in. Inv. Kein asked if that was the only cell phone he used and he advised yes. Inv. Kein asked him if he carries the phone with him or if anyone else uses the phone and he advised the phone is always with him, no one else uses the phone. Sean signed the consent to search the phone and I advised Tony that we were investigating a case where text messages were sent from that phone to a resident in our town and we needed to speak with him about that. He agreed to come with us and we walked him outside where he was placed into custody for the investigation at 1102 hours, handcuffed and placed into Inv. Kein's unmarked department car and transported back to the station for further investigation.

Upon arrival at the station we brought Tony back to the investigations area and into an interview room. At 1137 hours I read Tony his Miranda Rights from a preprinted form and he acknowledged his understanding of same verbally and signed the form; Inv. Kein was also present for the interview and witnessed the Miranda Rights. I asked him if he prefers Anthony or Tony and he advised Tony. I then asked him if he knew why he was here and he advised he had sent some texts a few weeks ago when he was drinking that he probably should not have. Inv. Kein asked him about the texts and who he sent them to. Tony related in summary not verbatim that he was at a party at his bosses house and a co-worker [REDACTED] was there with his girlfriend [REDACTED] and her children. Tony was standing at one of the tables talking with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] the kids got out of the pool and came over by the table and joined in the conversation. I asked Tony if he remembered what they were talking about and he mentioned that [REDACTED] ([REDACTED] daughter) was talking about the concert they were going to that night and belly button piercing. Tony did not remember how that came up but [REDACTED] had said she wanted one (belly button piercing). When they were leaving Tony asked [REDACTED] for her email address and she gave that to him. Tony advised he was drinking alcohol while at the party and did not remember everything he had texted her but recalled texting her email address. Tony advised when he woke up the next morning and he saw the texts on his phone he realized he should not have texted them to [REDACTED] and deleted them. I asked Tony if he knew how old [REDACTED] was and he thought [REDACTED] told him she was 14, he advised he knew she was under 18. Tony advised he has not reached out to [REDACTED] since the last text message on 8/4/13.

I asked Tony if he sent any photos to [redacted] and he advised no. I asked if she sent any pictures to him and he said she sent a picture of a dolphin. Inv. Kein asked Tony if he was on Instagram and he advised no. I advised him there was text messaging reference [redacted] from his phone and then she sent [redacted]. Tony advised he tried to log onto the [redacted] on Instagram but access was denied. He advised when he woke up the next morning and saw the texts he also observed the Instagram App on his phone that he must have set up the night before with [redacted] being his username. At this point we stepped out and advised Tony we would be back and asked if he wanted anything to drink and he requested water. Inv. Kein brought him water and he was also allowed to use the bathroom.

Inv. Kein conducted a forensic search of Tony's cell phone and the text messages that were sent to [redacted] were deleted and recoverable from his cell phone. These texts were printed up and we went back in to ask Tony about the texts. He admitted to the texts that were sent to [redacted] and advised he was drinking when he sent them. We advised Tony that the States Attorney would be contacted to review the case and he advised then he would want to talk with an attorney. Inv. Kein and I brought him back to the detention area where he was printed for identification purposes and placed in a holding cell. Inv. Kein contacted Felony Review from sex crimes unit due to technology being used. Inv. Kein was advised a Sex Crimes Felony Review ASA would be out to review the case. I made contact with victim's parents and advised that the States Attorney would be out to review the case and they advised they would be here at 1530 hours.

At approximately 1315 hours ASA Brian Shaw arrived at the station and was brought back to the investigations area conference room. ASA Shaw was given the preliminary report and also the copy of the print text messages from victim's phone and was briefed on the case and our interview with suspect. At 1530 hours I was advised by our front desk that victim and her family was at the station. I went to the lobby with ASA Shaw and he introduced himself to [redacted] and her family and advised he would need to speak with [redacted] alone. We walked back to the investigations conference room to speak with [redacted] I was present for this interview. [redacted] advised the same information to ASA Shaw as she did in my interview with her. After the interview we walked [redacted] back out to the lobby area and I advised her family they would be contacted as to the outcome of the case.

I was advised at 1900 hours that [redacted] was at the station with her daughter's. Inv. Jankowski met with them at the lobby and brought all three back to the investigations area soft interview room. ASA Shaw met with [redacted] and introduced himself to her and explained that he needed to speak with her daughter's about an incident a friend had told them about. [redacted] advised her daughters had told her about it on 8/19/13 and she was fine with them talking with ASA Shaw and myself alone.

At 1917 hours I brought [redacted] back to the conference room in investigations where ASA Shaw introduced himself to her; I was present for the interview. We asked [redacted] how long she knew [redacted] and she advised since kindergarten and [redacted] is now 14 years old. We asked [redacted] what she was told by [redacted] and she related the following in summary not verbatim. The information about [REDACTED] being warned by her mother about Tony and that Tony touched her butt was not revealed in my interview with [REDACTED] or the interview with [REDACTED]. The interview with [REDACTED] ended and we brought her back to the soft interview room and asked to speak with [REDACTED] again and brought her back to the conference room at 1955 hours. I asked [REDACTED] if she was in the car the entire time [REDACTED] was telling [REDACTED] about the texts and she advised yes. I asked [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] mentioned that Tony touched her and [REDACTED] said yes, she forgot to mention it earlier and related that when [REDACTED] told her the first time that she said Tony touched her butt while she was at the party. We asked how he touched her butt and [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] was standing and he touched her butt from behind but did not elaborate. [REDACTED] also related that [REDACTED] told her that her mom warned him to be careful around Tony he goes for younger girls. if she had told them that Tony had touched her butt and she advised she did and had forgot about it when she was interviewed by us. We asked how it occurred and [redacted] advised she was walking from the pool area toward the fire pit area and a little girl was in front of her and had pinched Glenn's butt as he was walking in front of [redacted] and [redacted] advised Tony was behind her and pinched her in 3 different spots on her butt as she was walking and said pass it on (when she demonstrated it was more of a grab). [redacted] did not react to this and did not tell anyone at the time. I asked [redacted] if her mom told her to stay away from Tony and she advised no. I asked who else was there and he advised Sean's family and other co-workers [REDACTED] and Tony. Bill advised Tony drove him to the party since they live together. Bill advised [REDACTED] was there with his girlfriend [REDACTED] and her children. We asked if Bill had met [REDACTED] children before and he advised that was the first day. We asked if he knew [REDACTED] daughter's name and he advised no. I advised him it was [REDACTED]. Bill advised [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were talking with Tony about country concerts that they have seen and that they were going to one that night. Bill said he also heard them talking about [REDACTED] daughters recent vacation to Jamaica; [REDACTED] children were also by the table. Bill hung around their area for a bit and prior to having dinner went out front to smoke a cigarette. Bill advised after he smoked a cigarette it was time to eat dinner so he got his food and sat down in a tent to eat. I asked Bill where Tony was and he advised he was standing at a table with [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and her kids eating. I asked Bill if Tony was drinking at the party and Bill advised yes, a few beers but he did not get drunk. Bill advised Tony drove home and there was no problem.

We asked if Bill ever saw Tony and [REDACTED] alone talking and Bill advised no, they would stay in a group ([REDACTED], [REDACTED] and Tony) [REDACTED] son was running around with other kids. At one point they were all up by the fire pit and this was right before [REDACTED] group was leaving. I asked when that was and Bill believed sometime between 5:00 to 6:00 p.m. I asked when Tony and Bill left and Bill advised around midnight. I asked if Tony talked about anything with him on the way home and he advised mostly work stuff. I asked what happened when they got home and Bill advised he went to his bedroom to go to sleep and Tony went upstairs to his bedroom. ASA Shaw asked Bill if he Tony said anything to him the next morning and he advised no, Bill got up around 10 or 11 a.m. and Tony was still in his room. We asked if Bill saw Tony drinking at the house after they got home and he advised no, he went upstairs to his room (Tony's) and he closed the door. Bill went to his room and did not see him until the next day. Bill advised Tony did not drink that much at the party; in Bill's opinion he was not drunk they only had a few beers during the time they were at the party. Bill advised they got there around 2:30 p.m. and left around midnight. We asked if Tony mentioned texting anyone that night and Bill advised no. Bill advised they talked about work on the way home or general conversation. We asked if Tony had a girlfriend and Bill advised he did not know, Bill has not seen him bring a woman back to the residence in the time he has lived there. We asked if Tony said anything to Bill about texting someone he should not have and Bill advised no. The interview ended with Bill and I walked him out to the lobby area.

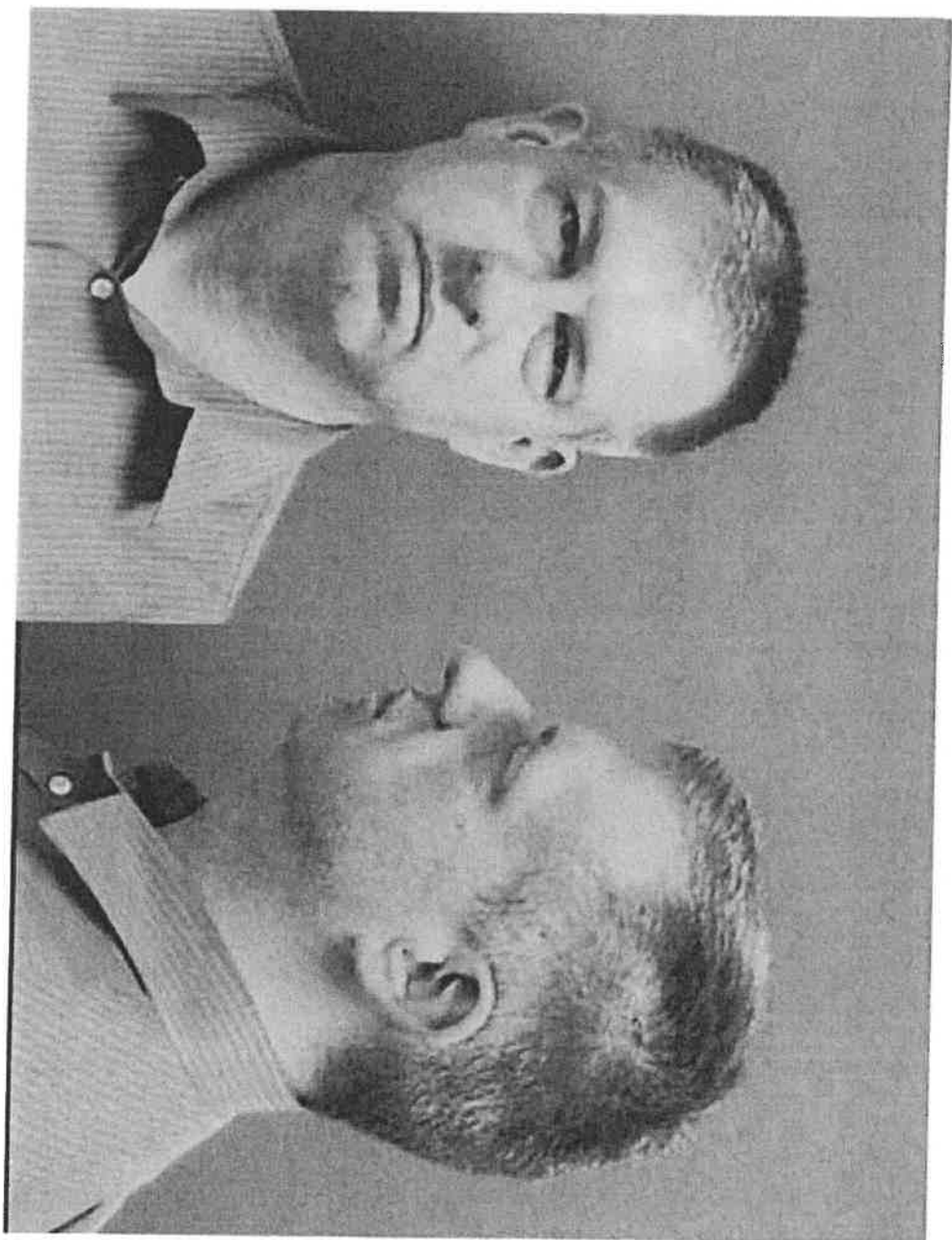
NARRATIVE CONTINUATION
